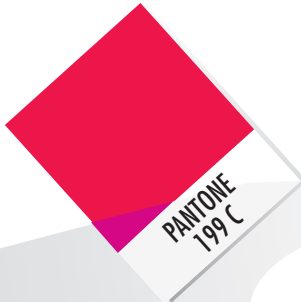

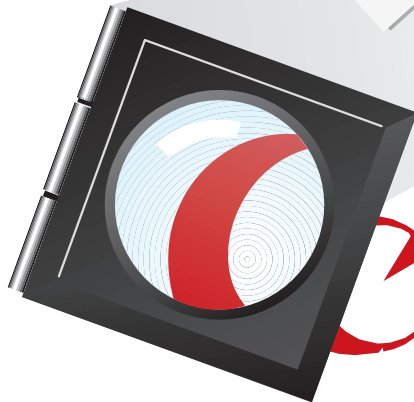

# Canon

NEXTSTEP has allowed Empire to move boldly into a new world of digital technology, but the company still outputs a huge amount of ink on paper.

The reproduction department faced short turnaround times and demands for professional color that typically required farming out requests to service bureaus. This approach was time-consuming and expensive. In addition, the high volume of proposals, bids, reports, studies, and analyses produced by Empire

required an industrial-strength printing solution.

With the appropriate hardware in place--high-end imagesetters, scanners, and networked copiers

from Canon--and proof printers from Hewlett-Packard, the reproduction department found that the multitasking, network-aware NEXTSTEP environment allowed it to bring the vast majority of its print jobs in-house. Print servers, accessible anywhere on the network, were configured with industry-standard PostScript fonts, eliminating the problems associated with incompatible font formats, which cause roadblocks--and headaches--on other platforms.

And for those few print jobs that still require communicating with a service bureau, the reproduction department can now rely on NEXTSTEP's built-in e-mail and fax capabilities to cut costs and turnaround times.
