NeXT Participates in the 1992 Campus Computer Reseller Conference

For the third straight year, NeXT participated in the Campus Computer Reseller Conference sponsored by NACS. This year's conference, held in San Diego from July 26-29, attracted over 300 campus resellers and more than 30 hardware, software, and peripheral manufacturers. NeXT sponsored a hospitality suite and concurrent vendor presentation, as well as participated in a multi-vendor presentation titled "UNIX in Higher Education" which included speakers from DEC, IBM, NeXT, and Sun.

NeXTSTEP 486 to Ship Q1, 1993

NeXTSTEP 486 is now scheduled to ship in Q1 1993. The original schedule for NeXTSTEP 486, which was announced in January 1992, was approximately 90 days more aggressive than this current schedule. The change is due to two reasons: 1) NeXTSTEP 3.0, upon which NeXTSTEP 486 is based, will be finished later than planned; and 2) There are many configurations to support in the PC world, and this extra work is expected to take an additional 90 days. The product looks excellent, and we think it will be a real market winner in 1993.
